Standing order / electronic payments

The Society welcomes members who set up standing orders or electronic payments but it is crucial that the reference which accompanies the payment(s) allows us to identify which member has kindly sent it – otherwise the payment just becomes an anonymous donation! So please, when making electronic payments or setting up a standing order, in the section which is normally entitled 'Advice/Reference to Payee' please enter your initial(s) and surname. That field can be only eleven letters/characters so please forgo punctuation and spaces if your name is longer. Please also advise us on the slip at the foot of the page that you have sent payment or set up a new standing order, and tell us what we should expect in the 'Advice/Reference to Payee' field. Please don't just put "IOMNHAS" or "Antiquarian" in the 'Advice/Reference to Payee' as that won't help us identify whom the subscription is from. N.B. The Society doesn't need or want a copy of the payment or the Standing Order or anything else with your bank details, so please just send us the confirmation slip below, either by post or email to membership@manxantiquarians.com When paying using electronic banking, as an extra protection for account holders most banks now ask for not only the destination sort code and account number, but also the name of payee's account. If the account names don't exactly match it isn't usually a block, but a prompt for the person making the payment to double-check before making the payment. The Society's bank account (as shown on statements etc.) is in the full name Isle of Man Natural History and Antiquarian Society but it seems that the full name isn't always used by the checking systems. It appears that at one point it was truncated to just 'IOM Natural History' or 'IOMNHAS' but more recently it appears that the checking database shared by the banks is expecting IOM NAT HIST ANT. (and whilst most banks don't need it, it would appear at least one bank expects the full stop after ANT. to be typed in!)
